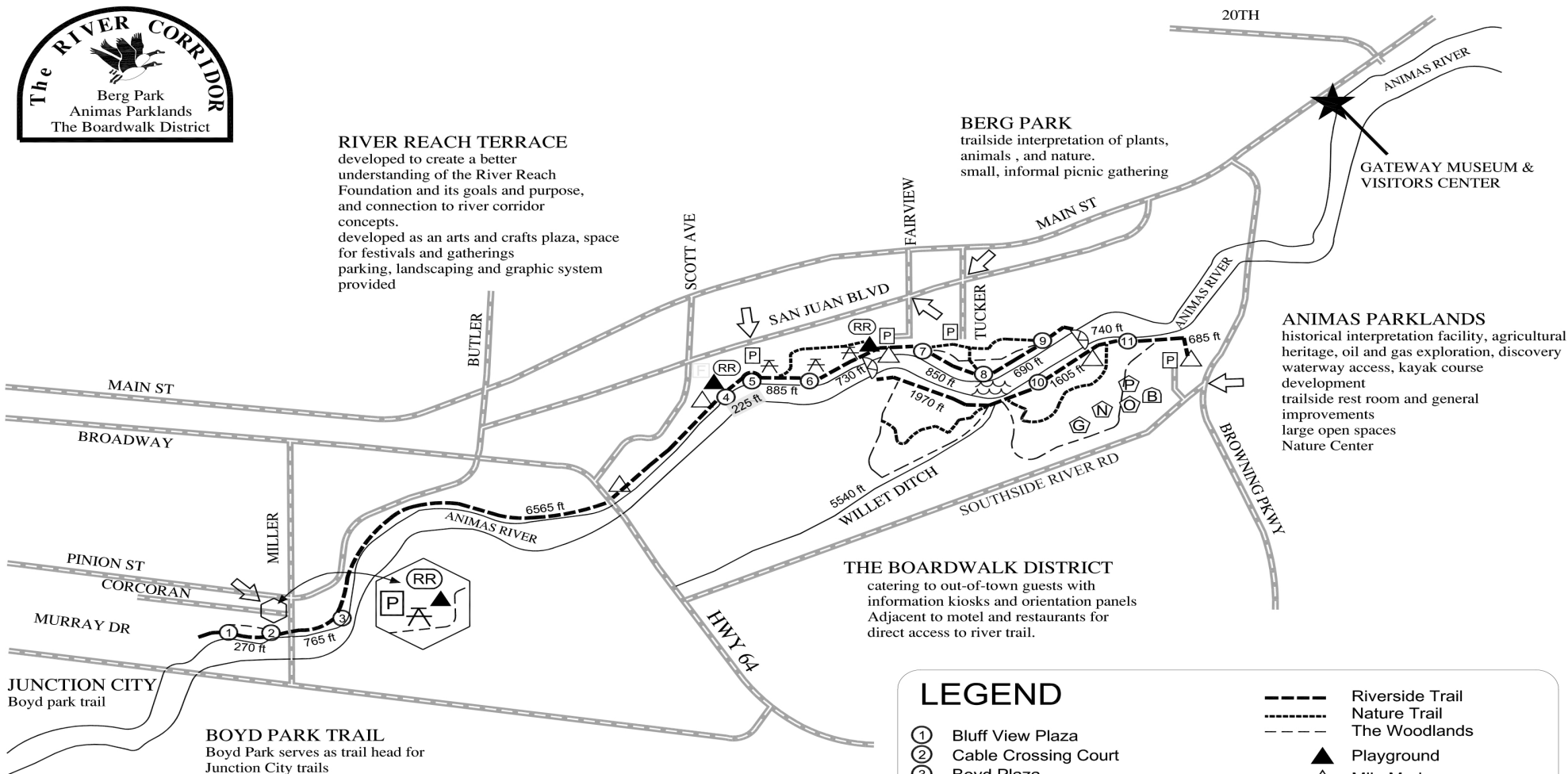
historical interpretation facility, agricultural heritage, oil and gas exploration, discovery waterway access, kayak course development

Distances

Boyd Park to Boardwalk = 1.1 miles or 2,420 steps

Boardwalk to River Reach Terrace = .4 miles or 880 steps

River Reach Terrace to Berg Park = .3 miles or 660 steps

Berg Park to Animas Parklands = .9 miles or 1,980 steps

Difficulty: Grade 2, some grade changes and uneven surfaces

Surface: 8 ft. wide crusher fine, concrete pavers, and wood-plank bridges

Explore over 8 miles of river trails!
